

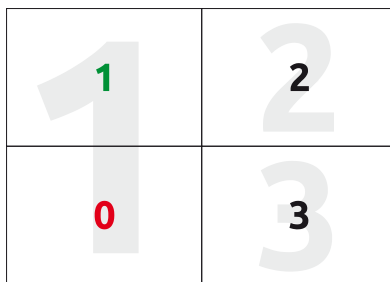
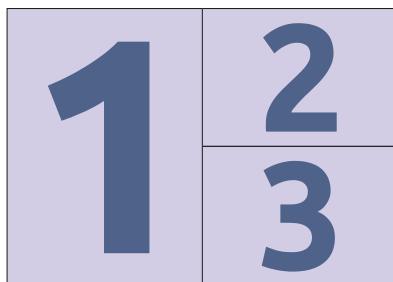
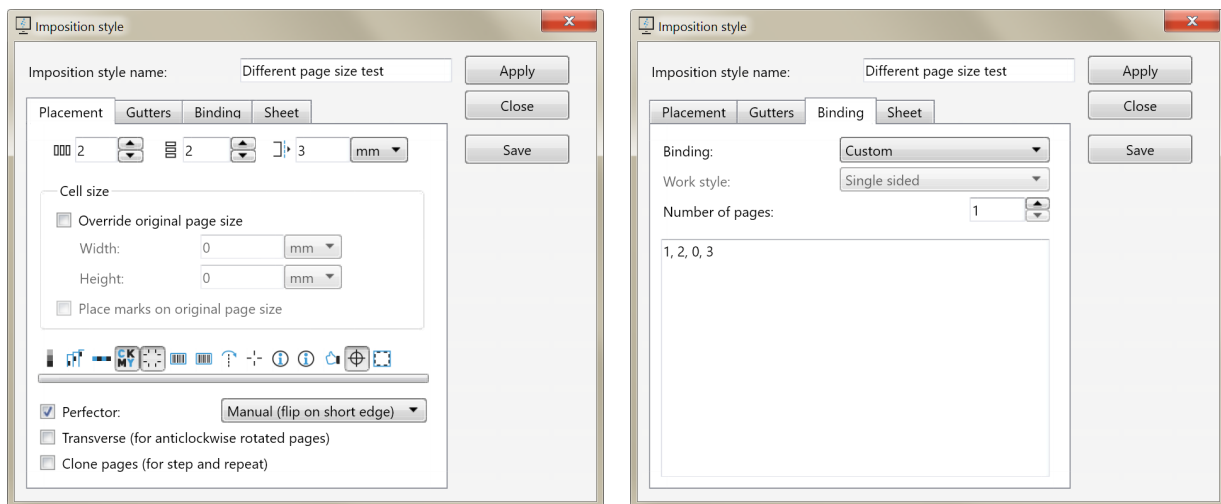
Impositions with multiple sized pages

Starting from build 167, StudioRIP is able to deal with impositions that, beside pages of normal sizes, contain pages of double, triple etc. size.

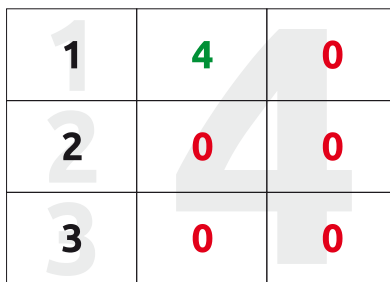
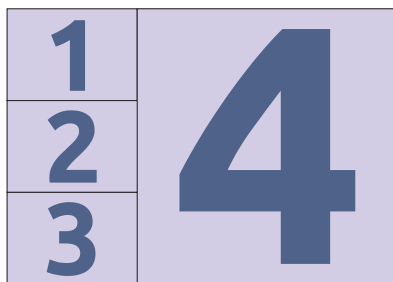
The logic of applying such impositions is as follows:

- the pages in the incoming PDF file must have the correct sizes (that is, a double sized page must have a double page size in the PDF)
- in case gutters are going to be applied, the multiple sized pages must have the right size that takes in account the gutters too
- the imposition must be declared with custom binding (see *Imposition style > Binding > Custom*)
- the definition of the custom binding will continue referring to the basic grid: for example if there are 2 rows and 2 columns in the *Placement* tab, the custom binding list will have 4 items, despite the fact that physically we only want to place one double sized and two normal sized pages (3 pages in total)
- the grid items that the multiple sized pages are placed to will be declared as:
 - the left-top grid item will have the real page index
 - all other grid items will have a 0 index.
